

Arts in Education Summer Arts Scholarship Current Middle School (6th, 7th and 8th graders) & High School Students

The Arts in Education Council (AEC) established the McClellan scholarship fund in 1996 in memory of Patricia Krewson McClellan, daughter of AEC founder Pam Krewson and her husband Chuck Krewson. Patty graduated from Saguardo High School where she was an enthusiastic participant in the band as a member, concertmistress and drum major.

The AEC continues to award full and partial scholarships to SUSD students so they can attend music and visual arts camps. Middle school students from any SUSD school may apply for funding to attend any one of the SUSD Community Schools fine arts camps. Funding for any other camp will be based upon the recommendation of the teacher and is up to the discretion of the AEC Board of Directors.

Applicants should have many of the characteristics that made Patty Krewson so special:

- ◆ a strong desire to learn,
- ◆ a passion for continuous improvement in the arts,
- ◆ good citizenship and a willingness to bring new skills back to their schools

To be considered for the scholarship, an applicant must submit the following:

1. A complete application signed by a school counselor. The application must include all pertinent information as well as a statement as to why the applicant would like to pursue fine arts education over the summer.
2. A teacher or principal recommendation.

Applications should be completed and returned to the AEC mailbox at the SUSD Education Center, 3811 N. 44th St., Phoenix, AZ., 85018 **NO LATER THAN APRIL 15, 2012** The scholarship recipient will be notified during the month of May and recognized at the AEC Recognition Awards reception, on Tuesday May 8, 2012.
